We have received word from DENNIS Uniform that 13% of the uniform pieces have not yet been delivered to you due to the "current global supply chain." We also understand that some pieces being shipped to you are not the ones you ordered, but alternative replacement pieces. If you have received alternative gym shorts, we are not requiring that your child wear those. If they are not the shorts you ordered, please feel free to return those to DENNIS, stating that you are happy to wait for the regular uniform shorts. In the meantime, your child is permitted to wear plain navy shorts. Moreover, we want you to know that we are not going to penalize your child for not wearing items that have not arrived. Please contact Mr. Brown, our Dean of Students, and he will be happy to work with you regarding any uniform issues.

CLASSICAL has partnered with FinalForms, an online forms and data management service, that will be replacing paper forms. FinalForms allows you to complete and sign enrollment, back-to-school, and athletic participation forms for your children. FinalForms saves data from season-to-season and year-to-year, meaning that you will never need to enter the same information twice! We are asking that ALL parents of students use FinalForms. Some Print-Forms Still Required

The forms that you are still required to **print**, complete, and file in the school office, are the SSO Household Information Survey and Free and Reduced Meals (you received a paper copy through the mail), and the OHSAA Sports Physical form. The physical form must be completed by your child's doctor. By law we are required to have a signed copy on file. Once your student's physical is received by the school office, we will input the expiration date into FinalForms, and then you will receive automatic notifications when your student's forms need to be updated.
