Please keep in mind the following in order to assist us in our task at dismissing students safely and efficiently. Thank you!

- Please do not arrive on campus before 2:40 PM. Students are still at recess until this time, and the earlier you come to pick up your child, the longer you will wait. Please keep in mind that we cannot dismiss the first group of car riders until shortly after 3:15 PM.
- If your schedule permits, please consider arriving on campus between 3:30 and 3:40. Those who arrive at this time will have the shortest waits, if any wait at all. And, this will alleviate earlier traffic congestion.
- Until our Traffic Sentinels get to recognize you and identify your car easily, please put your family placard in the driver's window when you arrive in the loading zone near the main entrance. This allows us to more efficiently match your child with your vehicle.
- When you arrive in the loading zone near the main entrance, please stand outside your driver's-side door so that your child can see you.
- Students will only be dismissed to vehicles in the loading zone (the first five cars in each of the three lanes).
