We continue to work to improve our car line dismissal routine, and we thank you for your patience. In our first week, we improved from ending our dismissal at 4:25 PM (on Tuesday, day one) to ending at 3:45 PM (on Friday, day four). We will have ten Traffic Sentinels (faculty and staff members) assisting with car line and bus dismissal; they are all committed to getting you on your way as quickly and as safely as possible. That being said, there are several steps you can take to assist us in our task:

- Please do not arrive on campus before 2:40 PM. Students are still at recess until this time, and the earlier you come to pick up your child, the longer you will wait. Please keep in mind that we cannot dismiss the first group of car riders until shortly after 3:15 PM.
- If your schedule permits, please consider arriving on campus between 3:30 and 3:45. Those who arrive at this time will have the shortest waits. And, this will alleviate earlier traffic congestion.

- Until our Traffic Sentinels get to recognize you and identify your car easily, please put your family placard in the driver's window when you arrive in the loading zone near the main entrance. This allows us to more efficiently match your child with your vehicle.
- When you arrive in the loading zone near the main entrance, please stand outside your driver's-side door so that your child can see you.

DashPass Update

We know that many of you have successfully downloaded and registered with the DashPass app. For those who have not yet received an invitation to download, you can expect to receive that invitation in the next few days. We hope that this app will assist us in making our dismissal routine more efficient. However, we will likely not begin using DashPass until the week of September 12.
