We will provide parents with full details on this simple process prior to Thanksgiving Break.

Kindergarten Siblings for 2023-24

The period of Open Enrollment for the 2023-24 lottery will run from December 19 through February 28. As a parent of a current Cincy Classical student, your student's siblings entering grades K-7 next year will have enrollment priority. If you have a child who is entering kindergarten next year, we will guarantee a seat for that student due to our charter's policy of sibling priority. Please note we can only guarantee a sibling seat for kindergarten. Again, if you have a child who will be entering kindergarten next year (23-24), we kindly ask you to email our Enrollment Manager, Mrs. O'Callaghan.
