The master calendar for the 2023-24 academic year is now available for your planning purposes. Please note that the first day of school for grades 1-7 will be Tuesday, August 29, 2023. The first day for kindergartners will be one week later on Tuesday, September 5. The last day of school for all students will be May 31, 2024.

Re-Enrollment for 2023-24

We ask that you express your intent to re-enroll your child(ren) for the 2023-24 school year. We guarantee spots for the 2023-24 school year for all students who are currently enrolled at Cincinnati Classical Academy, provided that the student remains in good academic and disciplinary standing and that re-enrollment is confirmed by February 28. The re-enrollment process of your current CLASSICAL student(s) consists of logging into your <u>Schoolmint Dashboard</u>, clicking on "ADD A FORM" for each current student, then filling in the re-enrollment information that is listed. Please note that registration for NEW students will begin on December 19.

Kindergarten Siblings for 2023-24

If you have a child who will be entering kindergarten next year (23-24), we kindly ask you to contact our Enrollment Manager, <u>Mrs. O'Callaghan</u>. This helps us to plan for next year. The period of Open Enrollment for the 2023-24 lottery will run from December 19 through February 28. As a parent of a current Cincy Classical student, your student's siblings entering grades K-7 next year will have lottery priority. If you have a child who is entering kindergarten next year, we will guarantee a seat for that student. Please note we can only guarantee a sibling seat for kindergarten. Again, if you have a child who will be entering kindergarten next you to email our Enrollment Manager, <u>Mrs. O'Callaghan</u>, if you have not yet done so.

In the case of snow, sleet, freezing rain, or other extreme weather conditions that could potentially affect our ability to safely get to school on time (or at all), please check your email, voice mail, and text messages for an official notification from the school of weather delays or closures. You may also check in with Channel 5 WLWT, which will carry official notifications from Cincinnati Classical Academy. In some cases we'll operate on a 90-minute delay, and the school day will begin at 9:45 AM. When school is closed, please know that all school activities will also be canceled for that day. The decision to close school or operate on a 90-minute delay will typically be made by 6:15 AM.
