Classroom Newsletters

You may have noticed that each homeroom teacher sends a weekly email newsletter to parents of all students in the class. This is an important part of CLASSICAL culture. The newsletters address what has been going on in your child's classroom, what students have been studying and learning, and what to expect in the coming week. Please note, however, that the teacher newsletter is not meant to include homework assignments and assessment dates. All homework information and due dates need to be recorded by the student in his or her homework planner each day. An equally essential part of CLASSICAL culture is setting the expectation that our students take responsibility for their work. We want students to get in the habit of taking responsibility for recording their own assignments; that's why all students must come to school each day with their homework planner.

Washington's Winter Break

Please note that school will not be in session on Friday, February 17 and Monday, February 20, in honor of Presidents' Day. Although the holiday is now most often referred to as Presidents' Day, the observed federal holiday is officially called "Washington's Birthday." Historically, Americans began celebrating George Washington's Birthday just months after his death, long before Congress declared the day a federal holiday. It was not until 1879, under President Rutherford B. Hayes, that Washington's Birthday became a legal holiday, to be observed on his birthday, February 22. Since 1968, the federal holiday was moved to the closest Monday.
