### **Standardized Testing**

Under the Every Child Succeeds Act of 2015, all public community schools must participate in standardized testing. These tests are used as a measure of school success, and each school receives a grade on the "Nation's Report Card." Therefore, it is very important that our students perform to the best of their abilities on these tests. Students in grades 1 through 6 will participate in testing this week from April 4-6.

- Grades 1 and 2 will take the Reading Diagnostic.
- Grades 3, 4, and 6 will take English Language Arts and Math
- Grade 5 will take English Language Arts, Math, and Science.

Please avoid any late arrivals or early dismissals on these three days. All students should bring two Number 2 pencils, loose leaf paper, a book to read, and a peanut-free snack each day. Sixth grade students may use a calculator on Math Part II.
