<u>Register now!</u> CLASSICAL is proud to announce that we will be launching our Veritatis Splendor speakers series on Tuesday, March 14, at 7:00 PM on campus in the Sojourner Truth Auditorium. We will be welcoming Dr. Daniel Coupland, Dean of the Graduate School of Classical Education, the Chairman of the Education Department, and a Professor of Education at Hillsdale College, where he regularly teaches courses on English grammar, classical pedagogy, and classic children's literature. Dr. Coupland has received Hillsdale College's "Professor of the Year" award and was awarded the Emily Daugherty Award for Teaching Excellence. He was a Resident Scholar at the C. S. Lewis Study Centre in Oxford, England. Dr. Coupland's lecture "Education and the Cultivation of the Moral Imagination" is open to the public.
