Standardized Testing Week

Students in grades 1 through 6 will participate in Standardized Testing from Tuesday, April 4 through Thursday, April 6. Grades 1 and 2 will take the Reading Diagnostic, Grades 3, 4, and 6 will take English Language Arts and Math, and Grade 5 will take English Language Arts, Math, and Science. Please avoid late arrivals or early dismissals on these days. Children should bring two Number 2 pencils, loose leaf paper, a book to read, and a peanut- free snack each day. Grade 6 students may use a calculator on Math Part II. Please make sure children are well rested and have a good breakfast during testing week. Under the Every Child Succeeds Act of 2015, all public, charter, and community school students must participate in standardized testing. These tests are used as a measure of school success and each school receives a grade on the "Nation's Report Card". Therefore, it is very important that our students perform to the best of their abilities on these tests.

Visiting the School

Please be reminded that visitors must check in with the front office and provide identification each time they visit the school. A visitor badge will be issued to the visitor and displayed conspicuously during the visit. In the interest of safety and security, parents should NOT enter the building during arrival drop-off time (7:30-8:15) unless they have a previously scheduled meeting. Parents may be buzzed in after 8:15 and report to the front office to drop off lunches or materials or to pick up homework for absent students. Parents also should absolutely NOT enter the building or approach the blue awning entrance or cafeteria entrance during dismissal (3:10-3:40). No teacher meetings will be scheduled during this timeframe. We ask you to please observe this school policy.
