Special Note on Early-Release After 2:30 PM

If your child needs an early release from school *after* 2:30 PM, we kindly request that you plan to arrive on campus for pick-up by 2:30 PM. This will help avoid any complications or traffic congestion during our regular carline dismissal. Ensuring the efficient flow of traffic during dismissal times is crucial for the safety of all students and staff. By parking beyond the Blue Awning entrance for early releases, you'll not only help streamline the process but also contribute to a safer environment for everyone.
